

Max records his efforts to control his anorexia in a therapist-prescribed journal that also chronicles his parents' difficult relationship.



After fourteen-year-old Eden is raped by her brother's best friend, she knows she'll never be the way she used to be.




When We Had Summer

When fifteen-year-old Bella's latest blackout lands her in the hospital, she enters rehab to confront her addiction to alcohol.




The Half-Orphan's Handbook Joan Smith YA FIC SMITH
